AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE PLATES FOR CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line
3 129 after the word "eye" the following words: — and pleasure
4 passenger vehicles owned by a veteran who according to the
5 records of the United States Veterans' Administration is receiving
6 a one hundred percent disability pension.
