The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MILITARY RECORDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary the adjutant general of the military forces of the
3 Commonwealth is hereby authorized to consult with the board
4 or directors of the Massachusetts Military History Research
5 Institute, Inc., a non-profit Massachusetts corporation for advice
6 and assistance in acquiring, funding, preserving, micro-filming,
7 cataloguing, indexing, and generally organizing records of the
8 Massachusetts militia.

1 SECTION 2. The adjutant general is hereby authorized and
2 directed to establish and maintain a military museum and record
3 center in the facility known as building No. 2 of the national guard
4 depot in the town of Natick which shall be open to the general
5 public. Said adjutant general is hereby further authorized and
6 directed to make military records available to the general public.
