### AN ACT PERMITTING STATE AGENCIES TO INQUIRE AS TO THE CITIZENSHIP OF APPLICANTS FOR ASSISTANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 151B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 4A the following section: —
- 3 Section 4B. Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter or
- 4 any other general or special law to the contrary state agencies shall
- 5 inquire and be furnished information regarding the citizenship
- 6 and residency status of any applicant for a loan, grant or assistance
- 7 under any program administered by such agency.
