AN ACT RELATIVE TO NAMES USED BY CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6. Chapter 110 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting the words "including any words or abbreviation
- 3 contained in such name which indicate that it is incorporated,"
- 4 after the words "under its true corporate name" in the second line.
