AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 68 of chapter 90 is hereby amended by
2 striking out the second, third and fourth sentences and inserting
3 in place thereof the following sentence: —

4 Any city or town which accepts the provisions of this sentence
5 may furnish transportation for children whose residence is more
6 than two miles from the school he is entitled to attend.

1 SECTION 2. Section one of this act shall not reduce the
2 amount of reimbursement to a city or town under section seven
3 A of chapter seventy-one of the General Laws; provided, however,
4 if a city or town does not furnish transportation its reimbursement
5 shall be at the rate paid in the fiscal year nineteen hundred and
6 ninety-one.
