The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PUBLIC AUTHORITIES BE SUBJECT TO THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 48 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 first paragraph the following paragraph: —

4 All offices and positions in the service of public authorities shall
5 be subject to the civil service law and rules. A public authority
6 shall be defined as any public instrumentality of the common-
7 wealth which is not subject to the supervision and control of either
8 the legislative, executive or judicial departments of state
9 government, or of any city, town, or county within the
10 commonwealth, and which do not receive state appropriations
11 either for operations or the payment of debt obligations.
12 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the following entities
13 shall be considered to be authorities: bay state skills corporation,
14 Boston metropolitan district, centers of excellence, community
15 economic development assistance corporation, community
16 development finance corporation, government land bank,
17 Massachusetts bay corporation, Massachusetts capital resource
18 company, Massachusetts convention center authority, Massachu-
19 setts corporations for educational telecommunications, Massa-
20 chusetts educational loan authority, Massachusetts health and
21 educational facilities authority, Massachusetts higher education
22 assistance corporation, Massachusetts housing finance agency,
