AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF TEMPLETON TO LEVY A FEE ON THE REMOVAL OF LOAM, SAND AND GRAVEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The town of Templeton is hereby authorized by bylaw to levy
- 2 a fee for each yard of processed and unprocessed soil, loam, sand,
- 3 gravel and stone removed from commercial gravel operations
- 4 located within said town.
