AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTED OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 2 the following section: —
- 3 Section 2A. Any elected official who is convicted of a criminal
- 4 offense in violation of the laws applicable to his office shall be
- 5 punished by an additional fine of not more than five thousand
- 6 dollars or by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than
- 7 three years or in a jail or house of correction for not more than
- 8 two and one half years or by both such fine and imprisonment.
