AN ACT PROHIBITING THE CREATION OF NEW STATE AUTHORITIES FOR A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, no state authority shall be established for a five-
- 3 year period commencing on the effective date of this act.
