AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE BLOOD ALCOHOL PERCENTAGE PRESUMPTIONS FOR DETERMINING INTOXICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in lines 341 and 342, the word "ten" and inserting
4 in place thereof, in each instance, the word: — eight.

1 SECTION 2. Section 8 of chapter 111B of the General Laws,
2 as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 11
3 and 20, the word "ten" and inserting in place thereof, in each
4 instance, the word: — eight.
