AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSIENT VENDOR LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 101 of the General Laws  
2 as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the word "selectmen" in line 22 the following: —  
4 ; provided, however, that such fee shall not exceed ten dollars for  
5 any individual artist or artisan applying for a transient vendor  
6 license for the sole purpose of displaying and offering for sale his  
7 own creations.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to all  
2 transient vendor license applications filed after the effective date  
3 of this act.
