AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MASSACHUSETTS MARITIME ACADEMY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES TO THE MASSACHUSETTS CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING COUNCIL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The board of trustees of the Massachusetts Maritime academy  
2 are hereby authorized and directed to provide space and facilities  
3 to the Massachusetts criminal justice training council to be used  
4 for the providing of courses under the provisions of section ninety-  
5 six B of chapter forty-one of the General Laws.
