AN ACT EXPANDING THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON RADIATION PROTECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 4F of chapter 111
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting
4 in place thereof the following sentence: — There shall be an
5 advisory council on radiation protection consisting of the
6 commissioners of public health, labor and industries, public
7 safety, energy resources, and environmental protection, the
8 director of civil defense, and the following persons to be appointed
9 by the governor: two who shall hold the degree of doctor in
10 medicine or dental medicine and shall be specialists in the field
11 of ionizing radiation injuries, one who shall have training or
12 experience in radiology, one who shall have training or experience
13 in radiation or health physics, one in radiation law, one in nuclear
14 engineering or in the industrial application of ionizing radiation,
15 two who shall represent citizen organizations concerned about
16 radiation-related safety issues, and one resident from each of the
17 state nuclear power plant areas as defined in section two-B of
18 chapter six hundred and thirty-nine of the acts of nineteen
19 hundred and fifty, as added by section twenty-four of chap-
20 ter seven hundred and ninety-six of the acts of nineteen hundred
21 and seventy-nine.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 4F of said chapter 111 is hereby
 2 further amended in line 16 by striking the word "twice" and
 3 inserting in place thereof the following words: — four times.
