AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by the honorable Joseph
5 Furnari, as he is a justice of the district court department of the
6 trial court of the commonwealth, in the town of Lexington, on
7 October 14th, nineteen hundred and ninety between Cerise
8 Jalelian of the town or Arlington and Andrew Jay Karpf of said
9 town of Longmeadow, and the state secretary shall issue to said
10 Joseph Furnari in his capacity as aforesaid, a certificate of such
11 authorization.
