The committee on Housing and Urban Development, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 537) of Francis D. Doris for legislation to further regulate public housing for veterans, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2804) of Steven D. Pierce and other members of the House for legislation to authorize certain tenants of public housing units to purchase the unit in which they reside, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3149) of Michael W. Morrissey and another relative to occupancy by veterans in state-aided low rent housing projects, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5686) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Housing and Urban  
2 Development be authorized to sit during the recess of the General  
3 Court to make an investigation and study of Senate document  
4 numbered 537 and House documents numbered 2804 and 3149,  
5 relative to public housing.

6 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results  
7 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
9 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of  
10 the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday  
11 in December, nineteen hundred and ninety.
