Bourque (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to direct the State Secretary to place a certain question on the biennial state election ballot in the city of Fitchburg in the current year. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE SECRETARY TO PLACE A CERTAIN QUESTION ON THE BIENNIAL STATE ELECTION BALLOT IN THE CITY OF FITCHBURG IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state secretary shall cause the following question to be
2 placed on the official ballot to be used in the city of Fitchburg
3 at the biennial state election to be held in the year nineteen
4 hundred and ninety: —

5 “Shall the city of Fitchburg be allowed to assess an additional
6 \$200,000 in real estate and personal property taxes for the purpose
7 of funding the ambulance service in the Fitchburg fire department
8 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1991?

9 YES NO”

10 Said question shall be deemed approved if a majority of the
11 persons voting thereon shall vote “yes”.
