AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this Act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the  
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared  
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation  
5 of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter  
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, or any other general  
3 or special law to the contrary, the state secretary may authorize  
4 in the manner set forth under said section thirty-nine, the  
5 solemnization of a marriage by Virginia Lee Koebke in the Town  
6 of Dudley, on October seventh, nineteen hundred and ninety  
7 between Andrea L. Cristina of Dudley and William J. Trifone of  
8 Southbridge, and the state secretary shall issue to said Virginia  
9 Lee Koebke a certificate of such authorization.
