AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONSECUTIVE SENTENCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28 of chapter 279 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: — A convict sentenced to state prison under this section
5 shall be discharged at the expiration of his sentence thereto.
