AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DRACUT TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF WINES AND MALT BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter  
2 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing  
3 authority of the town of Dracut is hereby authorized to issue a  
4 license for the sale of wine and malt beverages not to be drunk  
5 on the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said  
6 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight to Convenience Plus,  
7 subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and  
8 thirty-eight except for section seventeen; provided, however, that  
9 the licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said license  
10 to any other persons, organization, corporation or location; and  
11 provided, further, that the issuing of this license shall reduce by  
12 one any increase in licenses issued under the provisions of said  
13 section seventeen.
