### AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE MASSACHUSETTS SOLID WASTE POLICY ACT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one hundred and fifty A of chapter one  
2 hundred and eleven of the General Laws as appearing in the 1988  
3 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 42 after  
4 the first sentence of the fourth paragraph, the following two  
5 sentences: —

6 A copy of the application for site assignment shall be filed with  
7 the board of health of any municipality within one-half mile of  
8 the proposed site. Any municipality within such one-half mile  
9 shall be afforded all the procedural rights of an abutter for the  
10 purpose of administrative review by the department or public  
11 hearing by the board of health where the proposed site is located.

1 SECTION 2. Section one hundred and fifty A of chapter one  
2 hundred and eleven of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
3 striking out the sentence added by section two hundred and eighty-  
4 seven of chapter one hundred and fifty of the acts of nineteen  
5 hundred and ninety.

1 SECTION 3. Section one hundred and fifty A<sup>1/2</sup> of chapter one  
2 hundred and eleven of the General Laws as appearing in the 1988  
3 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after line thirty-  
4 four the following clause:

5 (17) The potential adverse impacts on communities within one-  
6 half mile of the proposed site including the potential adverse  
7 impacts on the considerations stated within this section for which  
8 site suitability standards and criteria are established.
