*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 19 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 24 the following section: —
- 3 Services will be guaranteed for persons with mental retardation
- 4 50 years of age and over.
