AN ACT RELATIVE TO STATEMENTS OF VICTIMS IN CRIMINAL CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 258B of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 420 of the Acts of 1986, is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out the words "submit such information" in clause (h)
- 4 and inserting in place thereof the following words: — submit any
- 5 such written statement.
