The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT TO CORRECT CERTAIN JUDICIAL SALARIES IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section twenty of chapter six
2 hundred and forty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 eighty-seven, any person appointed on or after July 1, 1987 to a
4 position, the salary of which is fixed by the provisions of section
5 twenty-two of chapter two hundred and eleven, section two of
6 chapter two hundred and eleven A or section four of chapter two
7 hundred and eleven B of the General Laws, shall receive the salary
8 or compensation provided for such position by sections three to
9 eight, inclusive, of said chapter six hundred and forty-eight of the
10 acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-seven, to be effective as of
11 the date of his or her appointment.
