AN ACT FURTHER CLARIFYING SMALL CLAIMS PROCEDURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 23 of Chapter 218 is hereby amended by adding at the
- 2 end thereof paragraph nine to read as follows: — A judgement
- 3 in an action for property damage caused by a motor vehicle begun
- 4 under the procedure shall not have any res judicata, collateral
- 5 estoppel or other preclusive effect on any other action arising out
- 6 of the same cause of action.
