AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE NUMBER PLATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out, in line 111 the words “without charge”.

1 SECTION 2. Said Chapter 90 is hereby further amended, in  
2 section 6B, by striking out, in line 3, the words “or for all motor  
3 vehicles”.

1 SECTION 3. Said Chapter 90 is hereby further amended, in  
2 section 33, by adding, after the paragraph contained in line 4, the  
3 following paragraph: —

4 For each number plate issued, the registrar shall charge, in  
5 addition to any other fee required herein, a manufacturing fee not  
6 to exceed \$.05 above actual cost per plate to be collected and  
7 deposited in a registration number plate fund for the sole purpose  
8 of manufacturing number plates.
