In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PENSIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22D of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after subsection
3 (12), the following new subsection:

4 (12a) Any system accepting any annual pension funding grant
5 pursuant to this section shall be deemed to have accepted the fol-
6 lowing: Notwithstanding any General or Special Law to the
7 contrary, a person who is a member in service of a retirement
8 system under the provisions of this chapter shall be credited for
9 retirement purposes with time spent in the Military service of the
10 United States; provided, however, that such credit shall not exceed
11 four (4) years; provided further that prior to the retirement of such
12 person, he/she shall contribute to the retirement fund of such
13 system, a sum equal to the current percentage contributed to the
14 retirement system by such person, payable in equal monthly
15 installments, unless a hardship exists prior to retirement, in which
16 case such deductions may be made immediately after retirement;
17 and provided further that such person was honorably discharged
18 from such military service.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 22D is further amended by replacing
2 in the second paragraph, line three the word "one" and inserting
3 the word "two".

1 SECTION 3. Said section 22D is further amended by replacing
 2 in the fourth paragraph of subsection 1, the word "ninety" and
 3 inserting the word "ninety-one".

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
