By Mr. Thomas P. White, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1141) of Thomas P. White for legislation relative to the retirement benefits of Joseph L. Judge, Jr. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF JOSEPH L. JUDGE, JR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation
2 to the contrary, Joseph L. Judge, Jr., of Worcester, former faculty
3 member at Quinsigamond Community College, shall for the
4 purpose of determining his retirement benefits from the state
5 employee's retirement system be credited with total service to said
6 institution. Compensation shall be granted to said individual
7 subject to chapter 32 section 12 of the Massachusetts General
8 Laws.
