## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 354 of the Acts of 1952, as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 354 of the Acts of 1980, is hereby amended
- 3 by striking the first sentence of second paragraph and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following sentence: -
- 5 The Massachusetts Turnpike Authority shall consist of five
- 6 members, to be appointed by the governor, by and with the advice
- 7 and consent of the council, who shall be residents of the
- 8 commonwealth, not more than three of whom shall be of the same
- 9 political party, and at least two of whom shall be residents of either
- 10 Worcester, Franklin, Hampden, Hampshire or Berkshire
- 11 counties.
