**AN ACT EXEMPTING FROM TAXATION CERTAIN REAL AND PERSONAL  
PROPERTY OF THE LOYAL ORDER OF MOOSE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 404A of the Acts of 1966 is hereby  
2 amended by inserting, after Section 3A, the following section: —

3 Section 3B. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 27C of  
4 Chapter 29 of the General Laws to the contrary, the property of  
5 the lodges of the Loyal Order of Moose and subsidiary building  
6 trusts shall be exempt from taxation under the provisions of  
7 Chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, so long as such property  
8 is principally and usually devoted to the benevolent and charitable  
9 purposes of said lodges.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first,  
2 nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
