AN ACT GRANTING VETERANS A RETIREMENT INCOME EXEMPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subparagraph (4) of paragraph (a) of subsection A of chapter
2 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following
3 provision: — provided however, veterans retiring under the
4 provisions of section fifty-six through sixty of chapter thirty-two
5 of the General Laws shall have their retirement income exempt
6 from taxation after such veterans have been retired for five years
7 or at age seventy, whichever is first.
