### AN ACT REGULATING SO-CALLED JERSEY BARRIERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 after Section 2E the following: —
- 3 Section 2F. All traffic devices known as Jersey Barriers placed
- 4 on any public way shall be designed or placed to allow for passage
- 5 of wildlife either around the side of the barriers, or in the case
- 6 of those barriers placed together, provide an opening no less than
- 7 12 inches by 12 inches for the wildlife to pass through.
