**AN ACT REQUIRING A REFLECTIVE STRIPE ON TRAFFIC DEVICES KNOWN AS  
JERSEY BARRIERS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 85, section 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by adding after the words "highway markings" the words "the  
3 department shall provide that all traffic devices known as jersey  
4 barriers, whether temporary or permanent, shall be marked with  
5 a reflective stripe running horizontally for the entire length of the  
6 device."
