RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF WAR BENEFITS TO ARTHUR JOSEPH LARIVIERE OF HOLYOKE.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purposes of discharging a moral  
2 obligation of the Commonwealth, there shall be allowed and paid  
3 out of the state treasury, as provided in chapter 731 of the Acts  
4 of 1945, an amount equal to \$300.00 to Arthur Joseph Lariviere  
5 of Holyoke, who is an honorably discharged merchant marine.
