AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR REIMBURSING A CITY AND TOWN FOR COST INCURRED IN COMPLYING WITH CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF THE BOARD OF FIRE PREVENTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 To provide for the costs to the following city and town the sums
2 set forth below are hereby appropriated from the General Fund
3 for the purpose of reimbursing said city and town for their costs
4 in complying with the regulations of the board of fire prevention
5 regarding the testing and removal of certain underground storage
6 tanks.
