RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY TO ASSESS SERVICES CURRENTLY PROVIDED AT LAKEVILLE HOSPITAL.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of
3 representatives, the commissioner of public health, or his
4 designee, the president of the labor organization representing
5 employees of Lakeville Hospital or his designee, and one member
6 to be appointed by the governor who shall be a representative from
7 a community organization affiliated with Lakeville Hospital, is
8 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and
9 study to assess the services currently provided at Lakeville
10 Hospital as to their appropriateness and cost efficiency and to
11 determine whether such services ought to continue as they
12 currently exist or, alternatively, if other uses are more appropriate
13 to said facility. Said investigation and study shall include, but not
14 be limited to, a review of other hospital services offered in the
15 area; a study of the impact of a sale of Lakeville Hospital upon
16 area health services providers, the welfare of employees of the
17 facility and the health care services available to the residents of
18 area communities.

19 Said commission shall report to the general court the results
20 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
21 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
22 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of
23 the senate on or before September thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
24 ninety.
