AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter
- 2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
- 3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
- 4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage in the town of Eastham,
- 5 by the Honorable W. James O'Neill, who is a judge of the district
- 6 court department of the trial court, Barnstable division, on May
- 7 sixth, nineteen hundred and ninety, between Pamela V. Marshall
- 8 and Howard M. Pavlofsky, both of the town of Orleans, and the
- 9 state secretary shall issue to said Honorable W. James O'Neill in
- 10 his capacity as aforesaid a certificate of such authorization.
