AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF CERTAIN NON-PROFIT ASSOCIATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The fourth paragraph of section 32 of chapter 63 of the General
- 2 Laws as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out subsection (b) and inserting in place thereof, the
- 4 following subsection: —
- 5 “(b) Four hundred dollars, except twenty-five dollars in the case
- 6 of any corporation that is a ‘residential real estate management
- 7 association’, as defined in subsection 528(c)(3) of the Internal
- 8 Revenue Code.”
