RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE VERMONT WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAWS.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission is hereby established for  
2 the purposes of conducting a study of and making recommenda-  
3 tions relative to the Vermont Workmen's Compensation Laws.  
4 Said commission shall consist of three members appointed by the  
5 Governor, three members appointed by the President of the  
6 Senate and three members appointed by the Speaker of the House.  
7 Said members shall serve without compensation and shall elect  
8 by majority vote from among the members a chairman, a vice  
9 chairman and a secretary. The commission shall issue a report  
10 from time to time as it deems appropriate on its findings and  
11 recommendations, together with any legislation necessary, by  
12 filing copies of the same with the clerks of the House of  
13 Representatives and the Senate.
