By Mr. Birmingham, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 203) of Thomas F. Birmingham for legislation to provide for a study of the feasibility of a health professions stipend/loan program for certain needy students. Education, Arts and Humanities.

AN ACT TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF A HEALTH PROFESSIONS STIPEND/LOAN PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts State Scholarship Office in conjunction
2 with the Association of Independent Colleges and Universities in
3 Massachusetts is hereby authorized and directed to conduct a
4 study of employment needs in the health professions. Further, to
5 study the mechanisms of a stipend/loan program to assist
6 qualified, needy students, who are residents of Massachusetts
7 studying for degrees in health careers. The study and
8 recommendations shall be submitted to the joint committee on
9 education, arts and humanities and the house and senate
10 committees on ways and means no later than October 1, 1992.
