SENATE No. 220

By Mrs. Hicks, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 220) of Lucile P. Hicks, Patricia A. Walrath and Edward L. Sweda, Jr., for legislation to prohibit the use of tobacco products in public schools during normal school hours. Education, Arts and Humanities.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS DURING NORMAL SCHOOL HOURS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2A of Chapter 71 of the General Laws as created by
2 Chapter 641 of the Acts of 1987, is hereby amended by striking
3 the first two sentences therein and inserting in place thereof the
4 following: —

5 It shall be unlawful for any student, enrolled in either primary
6 or secondary public schools in the commonwealth, or for any
7 other person to use tobacco products of any type on school
8 grounds during normal school hours.

9 Each school committee shall establish a policy dealing with
10 students or others who violate this law.
