AN ACT CLARIFYING THE APPLICATION OF THE CAMPAIGN FINANCE LAW TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by deleting the phrase
3 beginning with the word "and" in line 88 through the end of the
4 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following phrase: —
5 and any person in the service of or employed for compensation
6 by the commonwealth or any county, city or town including but
7 not limited to any officer, director or employee of any state
8 authority or any trustee or employee of any state institution of
9 higher learning, and any other person pursuant to this chapter
10 including but not limited to sections 13 through 17 thereof and
11 any other laws of the commonwealth pertaining to campaign
12 contributions and expenditures.
