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AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTRIC AND GAS COMPANIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 3 or gas companies may vote, at a special town meeting, to
- 4 determine which electric or gas company shall be franchised to
- 5 service the entire city or town.
- 6 The Department of Public Utilities shall determine the value
- 7 of such utility subject to conveyance which occurs pursuant to this
- 8 act.
