The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RE SALE OF TICKETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Nothing contained in this Act was ever intended to prohibit nor
- 2 shall ever be deemed to prohibit a ticket seller, with the consent
- 3 of the sponsor of such baseball game, football game, hockey game,
- 4 theatre entertainment or other amusement from collecting a
- 5 reasonable service charge, in addition to the printed box office
- 6 ticket price from a ticket purchaser in return for service actually
- 7 rendered.
