

By Mr. Norton, petition (accompanied by order, Senate, No. 365) of Thomas C. Norton for the adoption of an order relative to establishing a joint special committee to make an investigation and study of matters relative to the State Racing Commission. Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

1 *Ordered*, That there is hereby created a special legislative
2 committee to investigate and study the Massachusetts Racing
3 Commission and its Statutory Authority under Chapter 128A of
4 the Massachusetts General Laws. Said committee shall consist of
5 three members of the Senate appointed by the President and five
6 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the
7 Speaker. Said committee is hereby authorized and directed to
8 conduct an investigation and study for the reorganization and
9 restructuring of licensing and other procedures and practices set
10 forth in Chapter 128A for the Massachusetts Racing
11 Commission.

12 Said legislative committee shall be provided with quarters in
13 the State House, may hold public hearings, may travel within the
14 commonwealth and may expend for clerical and other services and
15 expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said
16 committee shall report to the senate and house the results of its
17 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
18 with drafts of such legislation necessary to carry such
19 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of
20 the Senate on or before the first Wednesday of December,
21 nineteen hundred and ninety-two.
