AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A  
COUNTY OF BARNSTABLE LOTTERY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, the County of Barnstable is hereby authorized to  
3 establish and conduct a County lottery and shall determine the  
4 type of lottery to be conducted, the price or prices of tickets or  
5 shares in the lottery, the numbers and size of the prizes on the  
6 winning tickets or shares, the manner of selecting the winning  
7 tickets or shares, the manner of payment of prizes to the holders  
8 of winning tickets or shares, the frequency of the drawings or  
9 selections of winning tickets or shares and the type or types of  
10 locations at which tickets or shares may be sold, the method to  
11 be used in selling tickets or shares, the licensing of agents to sell  
12 tickets or shares, provided that not person under the age of twenty-  
13 one shall be licensed as an agent, the manner and amount of  
14 compensation, if any, to be paid licensed sales agents and such  
15 other matters necessary or desirable for the efficient and  
16 economical operation and administration of the lottery and for  
17 the convenience of the purchasers of tickets or shares and the  
18 holders of winning tickets or shares. The County may establish,  
19 and from time to time review, such rules and regulations, or  
20 ordinance as it deems necessary or desirable.

1 SECTION 2. All revenues from the operation and conduct of  
2 the lottery established pursuant to this act shall be paid into the  
3 general treasury of the County of Barnstable.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
