By Mr. Jajuga, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 563) of James P. Jajuga, Thomas G. Palumbo, Richard R. Tisei, Gary M. Coon, Brian S. Dempsey and Larry F. Giordano for legislation to provide for certain recipients of certain assistance from the Commonwealth to perform community service. Human Services and Elderly Affairs.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN RECIPIENTS OF ASSISTANCE FROM THE  
COMMONWEALTH TO PERFORM COMMUNITY SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 117 A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting immediately after the first paragraph, the
- 3 following paragraph: —
- 4 A recipient of assistance under this Chapter and Chapter 118,
- 5 who is not covered by the provisions of Chapter 118A and is over
- 6 the age of seventeen years shall be required by the department
- 7 to perform at least twenty hours of services each week for the city,
- 8 town, or non-profit agency designated by such city or town in
- 9 which such recipient lives for the purpose of supplementing the
- 10 existing staff and services provided by such city, town, or non-
- 11 profit agency. Those recipients who are the single parent of a pre-
- 12 school age child shall be exempt from these provisions. The
- 13 department shall promulgate all other regulations necessary to
- 14 carry out the provisions of this paragraph.
