AN ACT TO RATIFY THE CONGRESSIONAL PAY AMENDMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The General Court of Massachusetts hereby ratifies the
2 Congressional pay amendment, submitted to the states on
3 September 25, 1789, which states: — No law, varying the
4 compensation for the services of the Senators and Representa-
5 tives, shall take effect, until an election of Representatives shall
6 have intervened.
