AN ACT RELATIVE TO VICTIM ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8 of Chapter 258B of the General Laws, as amended
- 2 by Chapter 362 of the Acts of 1989 is hereby amended by striking
- 3 the fifth sentence in the first paragraph and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following sentence: — When multiple civil motor
- 5 vehicle infractions arising from a single incident are charged, the
- 6 total assessment shall not exceed fifty dollars; provided, however,
- 7 that the total assessment against a person who has not attained
- 8 seventeen years shall not exceed thirty dollars.
