AN ACT RELATIVE TO ARRESTS FOR CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE LAW OFFENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 21, of Chapter 90, of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph, the  
3 following: — Whoever is found by a police officer to be in  
4 violation of the provisions of sections ten or twenty-three of this  
5 chapter, or who the police officer has probable cause to believe  
6 is in violation of said sections ten or twenty-three of Chapter 90,  
7 may be arrested without a warrant.
