AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COST OF THE CLEAN-UP OF BOSTON HARBOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, the costs of the clean-up of Boston Harbor shall
- 3 be borne by all cities and towns of the Commonwealth. The
- 4 portion of said cost attributable to a city or town shall be
- 5 calculated as an additional expense of the water and sewer systems
- 6 of such city and town.
